Mission to Uganda

At the beginning of March, Teamwork had a conference in Mbarara, Uganda, with 600 people in attendance. More than half the attendees were pastors and leaders, traveling from Rwanda, Tanzania, Burundi, and the Congo. Many came at great sacrifice, as travel is not easy or inexpensive. However, this only served to heighten the expectancy concerning what God would do during the conference.

Though our team represented several nations - Kenya, South Africa and the United States -

we were able to flow together and see God move in a powerful way.

Please pray for Uganda. It is experiencing great revival. However, with so many new believers coming to Christ, the need for trained and equipped pastors is greater than ever.

Teamwork earnestly desires to see Bible schools planted throughout the world in order to train potential Christian leaders. In many developing nations, there are great numbers of new believers. Seeing the need, pastors step into ministry without being adequately trained or equipped. Teamwork seeks to work with these pastors and their people, enabling them to train, make disciples and raise up leaders within their own churches.

Through your support, as friends and partners of Teamwork Ministries, we can see many more Bible schools established and many more lives touched through our missions. We know that the mission conferences play a vital roll

Developing a Breakthrough Mentality by Dr. John Chacha

Last fall, when I was in Tanzania, I was asked to speak to many pastors and leaders from the villages surrounding Dar es Salaam on this topic, as well as on financial breakthrough. As I spoke, the listeners began to open their minds to new ideas, such as taking part in the worldwide economy. Many of the people at the seminar had great skills, but had never expanded their thinking to anything beyond small businesses within their own village. As I shared principles from God's word, new possibilities began to immerge for creating wealth and helping their people.

Shortly after returning to the States, I received a phone call from the pastor who had hosted the conference. She had decided to enter into a contract with the University of Dar es Salaam to build a dormitory for 5,000 students. This is a contract valued at five million U.S. dollars and will have a great impact on many involved in this venture. To the glory of God, her people are experiencing a tremendous economic breakthrough as a result of her action.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! II Corinthians 5:17

Faith is seeing and believing what is unseen. Don't let your five senses limit your world. God is well able to do exceedingly and abundantly over that which you would ask or think. Dare to dream impossible dreams. Every year, determine to accomplish at least one project that is too big for you to do alone. Take a risk. Trust God in new areas of faith. Let your faith muscles grow by pushing against the impossible.

What is a 'Breakthrough Mentality'?

A mentality is a mindset, a pattern of thinking, and a way of seeing the world. You have a breakthrough mentality when you are able to face the challenges of life with a resolute mind, when you are able to deal with oppositions, failures, disappointments, frustrations, and persecutions without giving up, when you are profoundly aware of the nature of the warfare that you are involved in, and when you fight, to be a winner, not a loser.

Why is a Breakthrough Mentality important?

The world continually attempts to make us conform to its standards, but God wants us to be strong, to have a Kingdom mindset, and be filled with His wisdom, knowledge and power. He wants us to be able to define and control situations, rather than being defined by them.

What are we to Break Through?

- We are to break through the world system, which persistently attempts to squeeze us into its mold. The author of the world system is Satan. We must go beyond our five senses, think the way God thinks, see things His way, and make decisions that are based on His word.
- We are to break through every obstacle that keeps us from what God desires for us, through obstacles such as: old patterns of doing things, apathy, lack of understanding God's will, financial constraints and so on.

How do we develop a Breakthrough Mentality?

There are three excellent examples that show how Paul had a breakthrough mentality:

1. Paul broke the bonds of the past

. . . and asked letters from him to the synagogues of Damascus, so that if he found any who were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem. Acts 9:2

For about seven years, Paul made a living from killing Christians. It started with holding the coats for those stoning Stephen, but then he went on to track down the early Christians, in order to imprison them in Jerusalem. He was stopped short by Jesus, Himself, and Paul CHANGED. . .

We must be defined by the truth of God's word -

- Not our past experience
- Not our disappointments,
- Not our failures, or mistakes -
- Not our family or our genetic heritage,
- Not what other people say about us -

We must see ourselves from Christ's perspective and live our lives as HIS NEW CREATION (II Cor. 5:17).

2. Paul found strength in God despite human weakness (Acts 16:16-25).

Paul and Silas found themselves in a severe situation in these verses. They were innocent of any genuine wrongdoing, but they were flogged without trial and thrown into jail.

But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:25

By calling on God and praising Him, Paul and Silas demonstrated their trust in God. Their

minds were set on something far beyond the natural realm. They were not defined by the prison cell, the stocks on their feet, or the deep open wounds on their backs and legs. They were defined by their confidence in God (II Corinthians 12:7-10).

3. Paul had a strong focus on the end goal

"But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. Acts 20:22-24"

Being utterly devoted to God's purpose for our lives is the only way in which we can enjoy the full benefits of our salvation. Only in this state can we find true freedom, peace and joy.

Christmas Miracles Continue in Tanzania

God is continuing to pour out His grace and mercy to the people of Tanzania after our Christmas mission. We have received reports that the blankets we were privileged to supply are being powerfully used of God.

There have been many reports of salvation and people coming to church after our mission. We also received two reports of people who, when they covered themselves with their Christmas blankets, woke up the next morning Baptized in the Holy Spirit and speaking with other tongues. They also experienced miraculous physical healing.

Our God always does abundantly, above that which we ask or speak. Praise Him! We wait in anticipation of many more reports of God's miraculous power.
