## Releasing Your Prophetic Destiny by Dr. John N. Chacha

This article is based on one of the powerful messages that was given at the Teamwork 2005 Prophetic Conference. It is a vital Word to the Body of Christ: "He who has ears to hear, let Him hear."

**The Lord our God spoke to us in Horeb, saying: "You have dwelt long enough at this mountain. Deuteronomy 1:6**

If you fail to break through the barriers of the past, you run the risk of spinning your wheels, going around in circles. God had given the Children of Israel a powerful vision, a vision of a land flowing with milk and honey. They called it, "The Promised Land."

When God led the Hebrew people out of Egypt, where they had lived in slavery for four hundred years, they headed straight toward the Promise Land. It was an 11-day journey, but it took them forty years to get there. They became stuck, going around the same mountain over and over. Finally, after the old generation died, it was time for them to move on into their destiny.

### 1. Conceiving the vision

A vision must be conceived and allowed to grow before it can be birthed. God gives the vision, but we must keep it safe until the right time. As we nurture that vision and begin to speak it out loud, we can take steps toward seeing it fulfilled.

**Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; do not spare; lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, and your**

**descendants will inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities inhabited. Isaiah 54:2-3**

### 2. Breaking the barriers of the past.

You will never go beyond the barriers in your own mind. If you think you can't do something, then you never will. If you're defeated in your mind, you've already lost the battle. If you don't think your dreams will ever come to pass, they never will. We must destroy all strongholds - wrong thinking that keeps us living in defeat.

### 3. Enlarging your vision starts with looking at life through eyes of faith.

**By faith we understand that the entire universe was formed at God's command, that what we now see did not come from anything that can be seen.**

Hebrews 11:3 NLT

### **Faith sees the invisible.**

Faith sees the future, the 500 Bible Schools, the growth in the churches we help, 1 million new disciples for the Lord.

### **Faith hears the inaudible.**

When I was a young Christian, I prayed in the hills of Naivasha, Kenya, and in the spirit I saw myself in Australia. Last year when I went there for the first time, it was as if I had been there before.

### **Faith believes the incredible.**

I have had the privilege of ministering to people who had incredible faith, like the women who had not been able to have children and believed God for twins. God answered their prayers.

### 4. Change the environment.

Find someplace where you can dream big dreams, a place where your faith will be elevated. Get out of that negative environment and into an atmosphere of victory, where people will build you up, rather than tear you down.

**5. Break the Curse** - this takes persistence. In order to fulfill your destiny, you must deal with those things that are holding you back. Israel had been under the curse of the Syrians. They were holding Israel back and Elisha came to talk to the king.

**Then he (Elisha) said, "Take the arrows"; so he took them. And he said to the king of Israel, "Strike the ground"; so he struck three times, and stopped. And the man of God was angry with him, and said, "You should have struck five or six times; then you would have struck Syria till you had destroyed it! But now you will strike Syria only three times." 2 Kings 13:18-19**

Don't quit too soon. You may be right next to your breakthrough.
