Dear Friends;

Just back from the Middle East, I am greatly encouraged at how the power of God is transforming His people there. He is infusing a renewed sense of freedom and anticipation in the Middle Eastern nations. Believers there are trusting God for the ability to reach neighboring nations with the Gospel. The meetings were packed every night because of the great spiritual hunger. Please pray for these dear believers that they will receive a Holy Ghost boldness and supernatural power to share the Gospel openly.

**God Has Been in Our Future!**

From the Middle East I traveled to Tanzania, East Africa, where I had the privilege of opening a new school that Teamwork has renovated and expanded for the people in that region. In Tanzania, the villagers are responsible for providing the school; the government then sends the teachers. The last time the education officials had visited the school, they were quite appalled at the run-down, unsafe conditions. There were only two operative classrooms. After making a report, these officials came back to the village intending to condemn the school, which would have left 1500 students without a place for education. But because of the money provided by you, our partners, and the efforts of Teamwork, new concrete flooring was put in the old classrooms and six brand new classrooms were added. When the officials arrived to condemn the school, they were surprised and pleased at what they

saw. The villagers were so excited at God's provision in saving the school for their children that they sang songs of joy upon my arrival.

By listening to God, we were able to provide a school at a critical time. "Thank you" to all our partners who participated in this project. By involvement in projects like this, we are not only raising people's standards of living, but also we are providing a relevant example of how God loves them, cares for them, and is concerned about what is on their hearts. Last year these people said to me, "We have many needs, but first, help us provide a school for our children." Now this school stands as a powerful testimony of God's love and is touching the hearts of many people.

**- Water Sustains Life -**

Last summer and fall, through partnership with Morningstar's Zao water project, we had the privilege of digging three new freshwater wells, with several more under construction. Since that time, this region of Tanzania and Kenya has been under a severe drought and famine, but, praise God, these wells have not dried up. They are now the main source of water for thousands of people. They even come from surrounding villages, bringing donkeys with water barrels to take back some fresh water to their homes. Once again, God has been in our future, providing ahead of time for a drought that He knew was coming long before we did.

**- Our Vision This Year -**

The AIDS crisis is taking a tremendous toll on the children of Africa. There is an estimated 1.1 million AIDS orphaned children in Tanzania alone. Over 8.1% of the entire population is infected. The greatest crisis is with the children being left homeless. In many areas, children whose parents have died have been passed on to aunts and uncles who, in turn, have died. There are literally entire villages quarantined by government officials, where people are dying and children are left without anyone to care for them.

For these past years, Teamwork has worked hard to raise the standard of living through building churches, providing clean water, building new schools, and starting Bible schools. With your help we want to go one step further and help the sick in the village, as well as the orphaned children.

One part of our vision is to build a clinic/hospital with about 10 beds, so that the sick do not need to travel so far to receive medicine. Once it is built, the government will provide the staff.

Another aspect of our vision is to provide Christian homes for orphaned children. These will not be big institutional orphanages, but will be families with parents (husband and wife teams) who will raise a group of ten to twelve children. This will provide a stable Christian environment, ensuring that the children are enrolled in school, attending church and learning valuable life-coping skills.

They will be self-sustaining, living on land suitable for farming and raising livestock.

Will you help us? These homes will cost about \$30,000 to build.

With your support we are hoping to have our first Teamwork

Children's Home opened by January 2007. Our first home will be the most expensive because it will be the mother home for all other homes. Along with it we will be purchasing enough land for several more homes and for farming. We will also be purchasing farm equipment, such as a tractor with attachments.

The main Children's Home will also serve as our mission center for Teamwork in Western Kenya and Tanzania. From this center missionaries will be sent to reach the unreached. The Kuria Tribe is a people group in this region whose lack of education keeps many trapped in traditional beliefs and hinders the spread of the Gospel. With this center, we can aim to penetrate and transform an entire culture by the power of God. Please, pray about how you can partner with us in this exciting new venture.
