## From the Desk of Dr. John Chacha

Dear Friends,

Greetings in the name of our precious Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! God is truly an awesome God who is moving powerfully in the earth today.

Last month I was in South Africa, meeting with pastors and church members in Johannesburg, East London, Worcester and Cape Town. In this great nation there are many people who, several years ago, thought they would never have the opportunity to attend Bible school.

Many of these people now not only have degrees, but also are serving as lecturers in our schools. Teamwork Bible College is one tool that God is using to make disciples and to train them to serve Him with passion.

When I was in East London, I had meetings with several leaders from townships who are hungry for God and desire to bring about spiritual and economic transformation in their townships. We are networking these leaders with other leaders across Africa who also have a vision for transformation.

I believe the Lord is calling upon the Church to bring transformation, not only in the spiritual realm, but also in the natural. Many churches have confined themselves only to bringing spiritual change, but we need to impact society in economic and political areas as well. We need to take the church outside the four walls and into our communities.

**These who have turned the world upside down have come here too. Acts 17:6b**

Jesus was a complete transformer of lives. He called people to give their all, to be a people set apart for him.

As a ministry, we are sensing the call of the hour to bring transformation to the nations. Through our conventions, seminars, and Bible college, we are training believers to bring transformation in their communities. We are also involved in transforming lives in the remote villages of Tanzania and Kenya. We have already built three churches and a school. We are also involved with Zao water project in digging numerous wells in Africa. Now God is calling us to build a clinic/hospital and to start homes for orphaned children. **Because of the AIDS crisis, millions of children's needs are being overlooked. It is estimated that by the end of 2010, one out of three children in Africa will have lost one or both parents to AIDS. Currently, fewer than ten percent of the 15 million already orphaned by AIDS get financial support. (Unicef)**

**Our vision is not to build a big institutional orphanage, but to provide Christian homes with parents to raise 10 to 16 children in a godly family environment.** This is a tremendous opportunity to show the love of Christ to a needy and neglected people. We are asking all our supporters to give generously towards this wonderful cause, to save the children of Africa and give them a future.

- For \$45,000 you or your church can:
  - purchase land for building,
  - purchase a small farm for producing food for the children,
  - build and equip a children's home that can accommodate 16 children.
- For \$50.00 you can buy a block (a portion of the building expenses). Nine hundred blocks are needed to build each house. We encourage each person to see how many blocks you can purchase to help us to provide a home for these precious children who have no home.

With partners like you, giving as they are able, we believe we can see the clinic and two children's homes completed by 2007. For more information, contact our office. God Bless You.

## Breaking the Mold of Spiritual Shallowness

As Easter is quickly approaching, I was thinking about Easter candy. Have you ever eaten a hollow chocolate bunny or similar candy? They look very nice and big, but as soon as you break off a piece you see they are more air than anything else. They are just empty. They have a good outward appearance, but nothing of substance. In contrast, a solid chocolate bunny has three or four times the weight of the same size one that is hollow. That is substance.

There are too many Christians who have a love for God, but have settled for hollow shallowness. Many Christians are living lives of low commitment to God and to their calling. They are content to go to church, and pray a little, but basically they live like everyone else around them, never fulfilling their God-given purpose.

### 1. Develop a desire to change to what God requires of you.

You will never grow spiritually if you refuse to change. Change can be painful, but it has to take place for growth to occur. We must be willing to let the Holy Spirit mold us according to the image He desires. We have to allow God to deal with us in all areas of life, such as our finances, relationships and commitments. We have to allow Him to deal with character flaws that hinder our spiritual growth. We must be willing to wash away our spiritual make-up, peel off the veneer of shallowness, and give our hearts completely over to God.

### 2. Move from spiritual milk to meat.

Every believer, at one time or another, must leave milk-feeding and begin to partake of the meat of God's Word on a daily basis, making their spiritual diets a serious business. With consistency, devour the spiritual meat like a hungry lion. God's Word will nourish you, strengthen your spiritual capacity and increase the level of God's anointing in your life.

### 3. Be a prayer warrior.

A consistent prayer life will help you become more effective spiritually. It will vitalize and revolutionize your ministry. No one can over-emphasize the importance of prayer and the great role it plays in transforming our lives.

Prayer opens our lives to new spiritual realms. It ushers us into the front line of spiritual warfare.

Honestly, how is your prayer life? How regularly do you pray? How important is prayer in your life?

### 4. Do not neglect your spiritual gifts.

Each believer has been given one or more spiritual gifts for the edification of the entire Body of Christ. However, because of negligence, ignorance, passivity or insecurity, many believers fail to exercise their spiritual gifts. Breaking out of the mold of spiritual shallowness will involve exercising your spiritual gifts and talents. It involves risking and taking a step of faith.

### 5. Make a genuine commitment.

Not talk, but real commitment. That is what it takes to break out of the mold of spiritual shallowness. True commitment will take your time, effort and will-power. Commitment will cost you.

### 6. Cultivate your spiritual discernment.

Discernment is the capacity to separate truth from error. Life presents thousands of choices, and it is through discernment that we are able to determine what is important and what is not, what comes first and what comes last. Through the sieve of the written Word and with the power of the Holy Spirit we can make the right decisions.

**Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.**

**Romans 12:2**

Many believers want an easy life, but God is calling us to an abundant life. It will mean looking at your weaknesses and allowing Jesus to change them into strengths. He is calling us to be solid through and through.
