Dear friends and partners,

It is great to be back home after a wonderful and very eventful mission trip. We have so much to share concerning the August mission to Kenya that we can only touch the surface here, but we will share more later.

The 45-member team did a powerful work preaching Christ in four different conferences in Kenya and Tanzania. I want to thank all of you who supported the mission and who gave sound systems, generators, clothing, drums, soccer balls, school supplies, candy and toys. They were all received with appreciation and immediately put to use.

A New Concept of Missions

I believe that, through His people, God is redesigning missions. In the past, missionaries went out, gathered people together, preached salvation, told them to be content in their condition, and left. Now we are realizing that there is more than getting people saved, healed and delivered. Missions is about total transformation. It is about equipping people to change their environment to one conducive to the glory of God. It is about preparing people for the coming of the Lord. It is about preparing people to confront urgent issues, such as ignorance, poverty, Aids, and immorality. God wants us to make disciples who are equipped to bring transformation into the marketplace and into all facets of their communities.

Conference in Nakuru

The theme of our conference was **Open Heavens**. I believe our generation is experiencing an open heaven in many areas such as in finances, business opportunities, healing and deliverance. God wants to release the miraculous and enable His people to walk in the same anointing as the early apostles. I taught about opening new doors, challenging everyone to walk through the doors that God is opening today, both in their personal lives and for their churches.
