We serve a great God who never fails even the the midst of storms and trials. We praise God for the mighty work that He is doing and are so thankful for everyone who is a part of it.

The mission to South Africa was a tremendous success (see article on the next page). As many of you already know, the day before we left for Johannesburg, we attended a memorial service for Dr. I. Slaydon Myers, Teamwork's Chairman of the Board, Emeritus. Dr. Myers and his wife have been great foundational pillars of Teamwork. Their leadership has helped to shape what this ministry is today. We want to thank those of you who have responded with financial gifts in memory of Dr. Myers. We have been greatly blessed and honored that he and the family chose to bless Teamwork in this way.

Another Great Loss

A few days ago, I received news of the death of a wonderful young lady from Tanzania by the name of Lucia. She has played a vital role in the transformation of Ntagacha village through her work in the church and by feeding and helping those who came to work on the wells and the school projects.

Six Children Who Need your Help

Lucia leaves a newborn infant and five other children. Because of the urgent concern for their care, we have already started Teamwork Children's Home in a temporary facility. If you are

interested in supporting one of these children, they need \$25.00 a month. We urgently need your help to care for these children.

Medical Clinic/Hospital

As stated in previous newsletters, the Tanzanian government has promised to staff a clinic/hospital in Ntagacha village if we will provide the building. We have received \$10,000 and need another \$40,000 to complete this project. The villagers will provide bricks and some of the labor, which keeps our part of the cost to a minimum. Help us bring total transformation to this forgotten people group. I believe God is calling His people into the marketplace - influencing economies, governments and society.

Teamwork Children's Home

We have already purchased the land for the first Teamwork Children's Home. We need a total of \$150,000 to build and furnish the complete facility. So far, we have received \$23,000. The goal is to have it ready for the habitation by August, 2007.

Transformation

We want to do our part. "To visit" actually means "to prepare a table for" and that is what we want to do - supply sustenance and show the love of God in a practical way. God is giving us grace to continue with the work.

South Africa - A Nation of Destiny by Regina Chacha

South Africa has undergone an amazing transformation in the past 12 years. On June 16th, the day we arrived in Johannesburg, the whole nation was commemorating Children's Day. This is the day, thirty years ago, that the police, under the apartheid government, opened fire on school children who were protesting about their subjects being taught in the Afrikaans language. This act escalated the struggle for equality until the fall of apartheid in 1994.

In light of all this, it is amazing to see how God is working to unite the churches and remove the divisions that have separated His people for so long. We praise God that Teamwork Bible College is a vital part of this process of changing mentalities in many churches. We believe that even our name - *Teamwork* - and the symbolism of our personal family as an international family, speaks to the unity God wants to bring to the church.

Teamwork Bible College was introduced to South Africa at a crucial time to meet the need for education of Christian leaders. Indeed, many pastors and Christian leaders did not have any formal biblical or ministry training, because it was never made available to them. Now they are very excited to be able to study and train their people through Teamwork's flexible and practical program.

While we were there, many graduates shared their excitement about the schools. The principals and the instructors love working with the students and seeing them come into their callings. They say there is so much life in the curriculum that it is a joy to teach. Students have even changed their work schedules in order to attend

the classes, sometimes at great inconvenience. For example, one student works each day until 10:00 p.m. so he can be off for class on Thursdays.

We had four graduations in three cities - Johannesburg, East London, and Worcester (near CapeTown). We also had one in a prison in Worcester.

We were amazed to see the excitement and freedom in the prisoners' worship. They love Jesus because He has set their spirits free, even while they are still behind bars. We saw the glory of the Lord on their faces as they worshiped Him. God's grace and mercy was evident in their lives. We couldn't help but be in awe of what God is doing there. Jesus said, "I was in prison and you visited me." Truly, He was there!

Thank you too, to those of you who are standing with this ministry. Your support is making it possible for Teamwork to bring training in the Word of God to the underprivileged and the prisoners and to bring light to the nations.



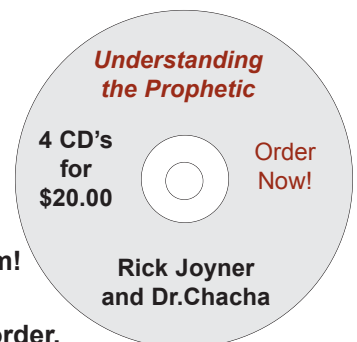
