Dear Friends,

Greetings in the name of our risen Savior. I just returned from an exciting and very successful mission to Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania. A great welcoming reception, complete with a brass band, greeted me at the church!

The convention in Dar Es Salaam on Kingdom economics was a great success. It is a joy to minister to people who have prayed and waited with expectation for what God would do through this convention. Across Africa there is a new breed of believers who are beginning to realize the value of economic transformation. They know that in order for the church to eradicate poverty mindsets the people will need to be reeducated on Kingdom principles regarding finances. This is paving the way for the believers to become more economically productive and in turn provide the church with more financial power to impact their communities.

I was able to use both TV and radio to minister to the entire nation. We had many people getting saved as they discovered the freedom that can come through Christ. I believe God wants us to raise our ministry expectations and take the Kingdom message to new levels.

From Dar Es Salaam, I traveled to Western Tanzania where we bought more land for Teamwork Children's Home. ## Great Things Begin with Prayer

## A Miracle Christmas for Africa



**Christmas is a time of giving . . . and what better way to experience it than to give to a child who is unable to give in return . . . to help a child who, without your gift, will have no toys or school supplies.**

Imagine being a six- or nine-year-old child living in a remote area with no electricity, no plumbing nor paved roads. Everyday is just a struggle to raise food and survive. Maybe you live with your grandmother who is in poor health and depends on you to do the gardening and to scavenge for food. You think no one cares about your plight and then someone comes and gives you a bag filled with school supplies, toys and a New Testament. What a treasure!

For the past two years, Teamwork was able to provide gift bags to over one thousand children in a remote village in Tanzania. Now, whenever Dr. Chacha visits, the children thank him over and over for everything.

Please make this a project for your church, Sunday School, small group or family. What could be a more meaningful gift than to remember a child?

To participate, please prepare nylon draw string gym sacks (sack packs) with 3 spiral notebooks, 1 pack of (at least 10) pencils, one set of colored pencils, 10 lollipops, one eraser, one bar of soap, one toothbrush, one tube of toothpaste, one toy (either a toy car, truck or tractor for a boy or a doll for a girl) and a New Testament. Label them for boys or girls or color code them. We need at least 500 of these bags to give to the children.
